Our Approach



There is a rising number of cases of online sexual exploitation of children (OSEC) during the COVID-19 pandemic. Since most children are staying at home, some are placed at great risk to be abused online because of the unsafe environment they are living in. The pandemic has made occurrences of OSEC worse with the loss of sources of livelihood and the surge of online activities of minors, among others. Apart from parents peddling their children to online sexual predators, other forms of abuse includes online sexual grooming and the creation and distribution of materials containing abuse and exploitation.
